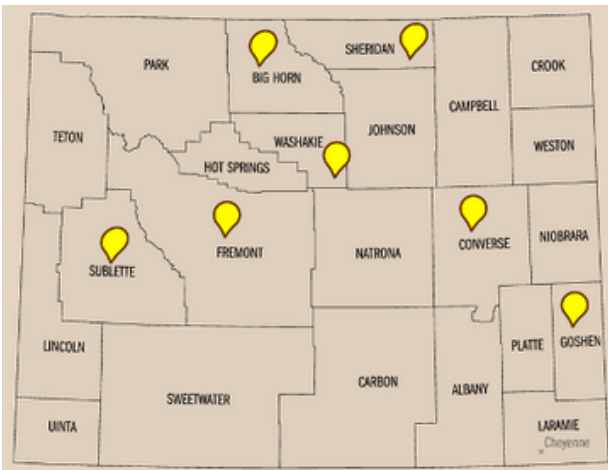




# 2022 EXPERIENCES REVIEW

Fencing, hauling equipment, windmill repair, haying, irrigation system management, planting a garden, working with horses and ATVs
